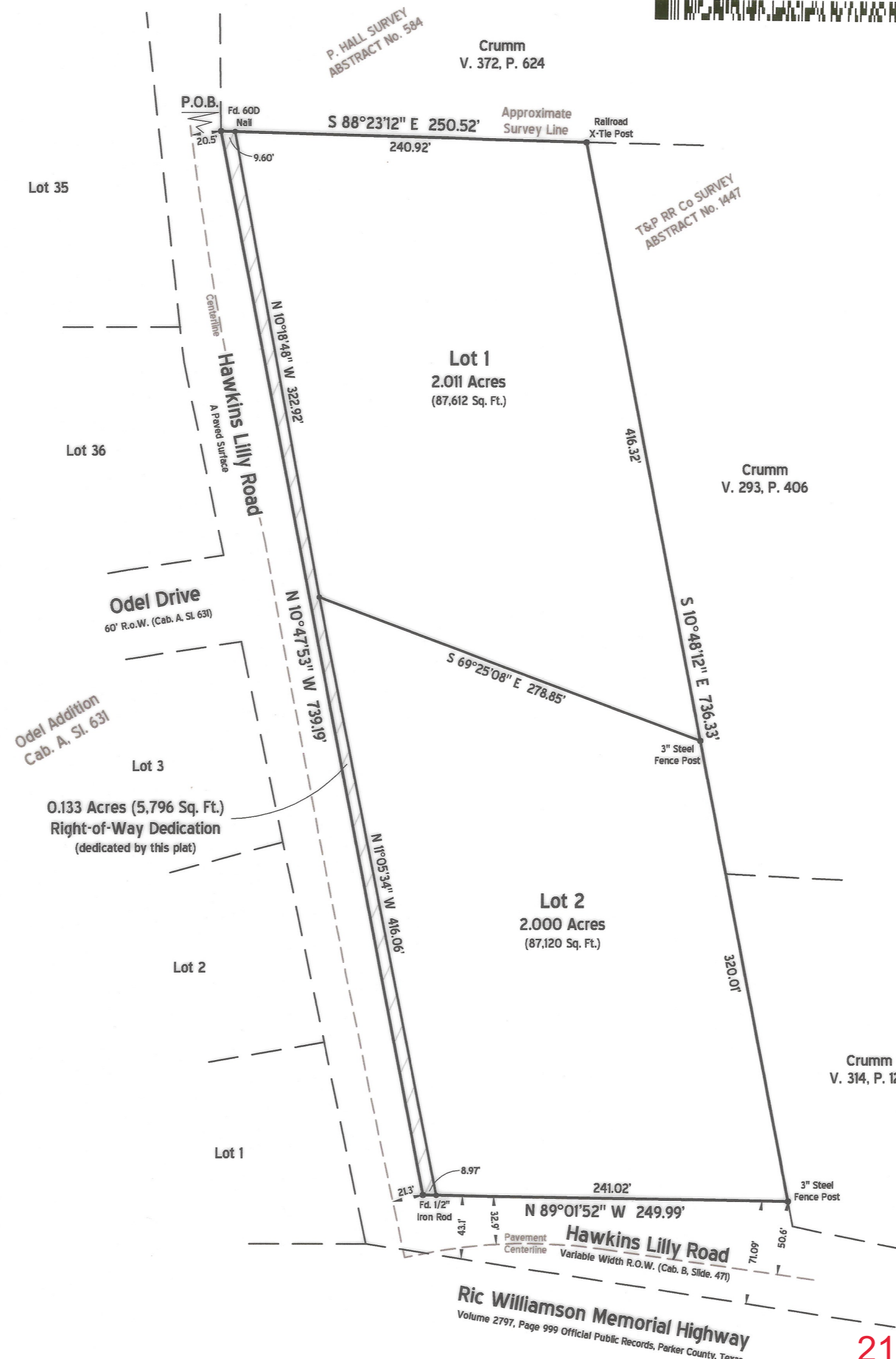

that Anthony Hughett acting herein by and through its duly authorized officer(s), do(es) hereby adopt this plat designating the herein above described property as Lots 1 and 2, Hawkins Addition, an addition to the City of Weatherford Extraterritorial Jurisdiction, Parker County, Texas, and do(es) hereby dedicate, in fee simple, to the public use forever, the streets, rights-of-way, and other public improvements shown thereon, the streets and alleys, if any, are dedicated for street purposes. The easements and public use areas, as shown, are dedicated, for the public use forever, for the purposes indicated on this plat. No buildings, fences, trees, shrubs or other improvements or growths shall be constructed or placed upon, over or across the easements as shown, except that landscape improvements may be placed in landscape easements, if approved by the City Council of the City of Weatherford. 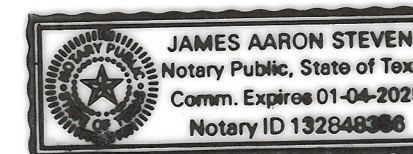
